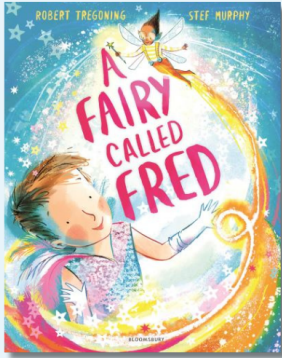


A Fairy Called Fred
