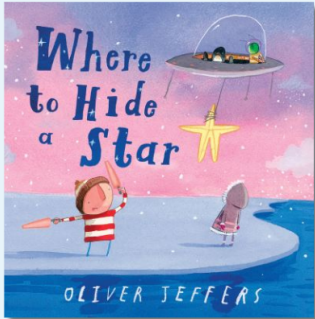


Where to Hide a Star
